Introduction to Small Loom Weaving with Sharon Gilsleider Supply List

- Have access to a rigid heddle loom (any size will work, a tapestry loom, or floor loom. You do not need to buy a loom to take this course- (you can borrow or rent thru yarn stores that carry the looms, like Halcyon Yarn in Bath). After the first class you will be able to decide what type of loom to buy if that is what you choose to do.
- 2. BY THE SECOND ENENING OF CLASSES: Yarn: 1/2 pound of 8/2 or 10/2 cotton (you will learn what this is the first class). You can use "crochet cotton" purchased at any yarn shop or Walmart or Hobby Lobby.
- 3. A couple skeins of heavier yarn like sock yarn, knitting yarn, or a second color of 10/2 or 8/2 yarn
- 4. The kit from Merrymeeting: contains yarn samples, a shuttle stick and some needles—cost will be \$20
